Guidelines

Every child (ages 9-17) is encouraged to attend the Antiochian Village Camp yearly, as it provides a great opportunity for spiritual growth for our youth. We as a church are committed to financially support young families who would otherwise face a financial burden in sending their children to camp. In return for our church's commitment, it is expected that each child applying for our scholarship be active participants in the life of the church. This includes regularly attending the Divine Liturgy, Sunday School, (if applicable Teen SOYO, Altar Server, Choir), Volunteer at Church Functions (Camp Fundraisers, Picnic). The hope is that the Antiochian Village experience will help our children build a firm spiritual foundation through which they will stay active and dedicated members in the Holy Orthodox Church as they grow older. As we pray with and for our children, let us always commend ourselves and each other and our whole life unto Christ our God!

Register - If you are eligible for the scholarship, you can then proceed to register and pay the \$100 deposit per child and inform the office that you have registered.
